

PRBB Intervals Course Proposal

Course Title: “Navigating the research environment. Tips from an insider.”

Proposed date(s) June 2-3; 2022

Rationale for course (why is this course of interest for the PRBB staff?)

Are you uncertain about what is best for your long-term career? Are you afraid of not fitting in academia? Are you worried you need to master too many skills? Do you wonder whether you will be able to enjoy your career after the PhD and as a PI? If so, I understand. I have been there. I have struggled; and I still struggle. This course will draw on my 25-years experience in academia to discuss those issues, provide some potential tips, and, in some cases, an alternative vision of navigating academia.

Course aim – general

Help researchers succeed in academia while enjoying the work and staying healthy.

Specific learning outcomes (what new skills, knowledge &/or attitudes will participants take away from the course?)

Participants will leave with a broader toolkit of knowledge and attitudes to prioritize what to do in each moment of their career. They will have a clearer understanding of the human angle of academia.

Course contents (outline of topics to be covered)

- The world of academia
- The problem of time
- Skills. A reflection on skills
- Professional interrelationships: people management
- Interviews: a different perspective on interviews that focus on the others
- Work-life balance: reflection and tips

Training methods

Interactive face-to-face training with roleplays, group work, group discussions and sharing and discovery with others. Short pre-course questionnaire before arrival.

Postdocs or equivalent - at least 2 years since completing your PhD - and early PIs (maximum 2 years from taking the position).
